Status: Abandoned. There were originally five entries. Four of these declared off, leaving the NACAI Council no option other than to cancel the fixture.

The event was plagued with changes of date and venue. It was fixed for 5/6 October, 1929 in Clonmel at a NACAI Standing Committee meeting held at Croke Park on 30 August, 1929. However, because of clashes with local GAA fixtures, at the subsequent meeting of the NACAI Standing Committee held at the Association's Offices, Dame Street, on 10 September, 1929, the decathlon championship was relocated to the Co. Dublin Board Ground, Phoenix Park on the 12/13 October. At the following meeting of the Standing Committee on 20 September, 1929, the decathlon was refixed for Clonmel on 13 October, 1929, at the request of Clonmel A.C., as an open date had been secured.
